CEC SCHOOL BUS REPLACEMENT PROGRAM FOR BERKELEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Berkeley Unified School District is aware that funding is available through the Carl Moyer Program for purchase of the cleanest available equipment, including zero-emissions and near-zero-emissions school buses and the charging or fueling infrastructure to support the use of these buses, and the Berkeley Unified School District was offered the opportunity to fund zero-emissions and near-zero-emissions school bus equipment.” The Carl Moyer Program provides grant funding to public school districts and county offices of education to replace old diesel school buses; and

WHEREAS, Berkeley School Board authorizes District Staff to apply for school bus grant funding from the Carl Moyer Program to replace an old school bus(es).

WHEREAS, that if recommended for funding by the Carl Moyer Program through Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD), the Board authorizes Berkeley Unified School District to accept a grant for school bus replacement and vehicle infrastructure.

BE IT RESOLVED, that District Staff is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of Berkeley Unified School District all necessary documents to implement and carry out the purpose of this resolution, and to undertake all actions necessary to undertake and complete the projects.
