
Low-Achieving Students Block Grant

Background

- LPSBG is a state education funding initiative with the goal of providing grant funds to districts serving pupils identified as low-performing on state English language arts or mathematics assessments.
- Students can't be identified for supplemental grant funding under the local control funding formula or be eligible for special education services.
- Must develop a plan describing how funds will increase or improve evidence-based services for the identified pupils to improve academic achievement, and how the effectiveness of the services will be measured.
- Funds can be spent by 2021 and be used for professional development for certificated staff, instructional materials, or additional supports for pupils.

Requirements

- The funds must be used to increase or improve services for low-performing students and should align with the LEA's LCAP.
 - Goal #2: Provide a high quality instructional program to all students
- The plan describing how the funds will be used shall be discussed and adopted at a regular governing board meeting.
