1. History of Process & Furniture Pilot

- January 16 2018 - The Board approved MeTEOR Education as the furniture vendor for the Furniture Pilot Project.
- January 29, 2018 - Pilot Teacher Application Due
- January 31, 2018 - Notified Selected Teachers
- February 7, 2018 - Pilot Classroom Walkthroughs
- March 1, 2018 - Facilities Staff, the Lydiksen Principal, and the 3 pilot teachers toured Richard Crane Elementary School in Rohnert Park.
- March 27, 2018 - Staff presented the pilot furniture design for Lydiksen Elementary School to the Board of Trustees
- Summer 2018 - Pilot Furniture was delivered and installed
- October 2018 - Check-in with the Pilot Teachers
- November 2018 - Meetings with Purchasing & Ed Services to create an Elementary Furniture Standard for new opened classrooms
- December 2018 - Delivery of 2nd round of pilot furniture.

3. Financial Impact

Options	Projected Cost
TK	\$20,700 per classroom
Kindergarten	\$19,000 per classroom
1st Grade	\$18,800 per classroom
2nd Grade	\$16,500 per classroom
3rd Grade	\$17,000 per classroom
4th-5th Grade	\$21,000 per classroom
A-la-carte options	\$100 - \$2,200 + handling, freight and tax

 - Delivery & Install: July 2019
 - New Classrooms Open: August 2019
