Priority/Focus Measurable Outcomes

Priority 1: Increase the percentage of students completing the A-G requirements and completing an identified Career Technical Education (CTE) Pathway as indicated by state and local data

Priority 2 - Increase student college and career readiness/achievement as indicated by: CAASPP, District Performance Task, PSAT, SAT, ACT (student hope scores)

Priority 3 - Increase Attendance Rates as indicated by future CA School Dashboard - Chronic Absenteeism indicator.

Priority 4 - Improve the climate and culture of our campuses as indicated by Suspension Rates and the CA Healthy Kids Survey

Priority 5 - Increase Family and Community Engagement as indicated by the Family and Community Engagement indicator/rubric

The funding will be used to achieve the above goals by providing the following types of additional activities and services at all schools in the Siskiyou Union High School District:

- Academic support, such as tutoring, before and after school programs, credit recovery, and summer school options
- College and Career awareness activities, such as field trips, college tours, job shadows, internships, guest speakers, portfolio development, and financial planning
- College and career guidance
- Staff development in the areas of college and career readiness and the development of A-G courses and CTE pathways
- Materials, supplies, and or equipment necessary to support the above types of activities
