



All students will benefit from programs and services designed to inform and involve family and community partners.


Elk Grove Unified School District GRADUATE PROFILE

- Support from classroom or workplace mentors




Academy & Pathway Data



Sacramento Regional Firefighter Youth Academy

- Partnership with:
 - Sacramento Fire, Sac Metro Fire & CSD Fire
 - Solutions for At-Risk Youth (SFARY)
- 2 EGUSD schools targeted: Valley HS & Florin HS
- Pilot program 2018-2019
 - 9 weeks – Saturdays, 9:00 am – 1:00 pm
 - 14 EGUSD participants – ALL graduated from program
- Beginning enrollment for 2019 cohort
 - 53+ EGUSD applicants

Sacramento Regional Firefighter Youth Academy

2018-2019 Pilot Program Statistics:

- Attendance rate: 92%
- Completion rate: 92%
- Average family size: 5 people
- Median family income: \$25,101 - \$33,760
- Avg. GPA for prior term: 2.83
- Avg. GPA for term completed in academy: 3.08
- Reapplication rate: 76%



City of Elk Grove

- Elk Grove Civic Summer
 - 5 week course – 10 credit Work Experience course
 - 2 week class at Elk Grove City Hall
 - 3 weeks of internships with local public sector employers
 - Marketed to all EGUSD high schools
 - 2017 – 3 schools participated – 22 students enrolled
 - 2018 – 6 schools participated – 30 students enrolled
 - 2019 Elk Grove Civic Summer applications now being accepted
