



  - 479 K as of 3/11/19
  - 505 K last year on 3/16/18



## KINDERGARTEN ENROLLMENT IMPLICATIONS

#### **Enrollment Implications for Short School**

Short Elementary School does not have an attendance area; they are the elementary school most impacted by any change in enrollment.

- 2018-19 Short Elementary: Grades 1-5, TK (170 students)
- Projections for 2019-20 Short Elementary: Grades 2-5, potentially TK (101 students)
- Projections for 2020-21 Short Elementary: Grades 3-5, potentially TK (46 students)

We want to be very mindful of how the size of a school can impact student learning, family engagement, the overall success of the school community and more.

#### Reaching Out to the Short School Community

Goal to serve the Short Elementary School community in the best way possible in the short and long-term given the enrollment information

- Many factors to consider and want to engage others
- Several meetings and community sessions with families, teachers and staff to hear their concerns, ideas and questions
- Transfer requests and placements for siblings of incoming Ks





### Overview of Conversations with the Short Elementary School Community

- Two evening sessions for parents, guardians and staff
  - 1. Focus on sharing enrollment updates and hearing concerns and ideas
  - 2. Focus on hearing ideas about potential options and paths forward, including:
    - a) Short Elementary School operates for the 2019-20 school year with grades 2-5, and potentially TK
    - b) Short Elementary School merges with Laurel Dell Elementary in the near future, potentially as soon as when the new Laurel Dell facility opens (tentatively scheduled for January 2020)
    - c) Working collaboratively with the District, families can request transfers to their resident school, or school of choice, on a space-available basis
- Also conversations with teachers, classified staff and others.
- The need for ongoing engagement of all stakeholders is critical.
